Introduction

The <u>Global Executive MBA</u> program from Cambridge University's <u>Judge Business</u> School takes **the fifth rank** in the International Trade Rankings 2023.

The teaching is delivered in week-long blocks, four at Cambridge, and two in international locations. Approximately 30% of teaching is done online and enables participation from speakers around the globe. The GEMBA combines live online learning with in-person teaching so students can operate around work schedules and participate from different time zones.

Participants will also take on an individual project and a live team consulting project, sponsored by external organizations, to explore new industries and test new approaches within an academic framework.

A constituent of the prestigious University of Cambridge, the Judge Business School attracts and partners with both public and private entities across sectors and the world for collaborations in academic, personal and professional development endeavors.

Program Delivery

Ranking first in Program Delivery, the Judge Global Executive MBA (GEMBA) combines in-person teaching in Cambridge (UK) and two international locations with live online teaching, allowing student interaction with the business, financial and cultural environments of other global economies. The part-time mode enables senior professionals to invest in their education without significant time away from work, and participants will receive full support for remote learning though the school's online platform.



Trade Program Content

Placing fourth in the world for Trade Program Content, the GEMBA delivers a highly practical curriculum that builds in-depth understanding of different disciplines of management, from trade macroeconomics and financial imperatives to cultural intelligence and management effectiveness. Core to the GEMBA journey is the International Business Study Trip, where students meet local business leaders and government officials and visit leading domestic and international organizations to understand the varied responses to globalization.



Industry Engagement

The Judge Business School is well-connected with both corporate and non-corporate stakeholders for education sponsorship, business projects, guest lectures and executive coaching. Its rich network of partners and wide range of collaborative initiatives place the school among the top 10 globally for Partnerships with Employers and Partnering with Industry Bodies.
