The Anderson MBA offered by University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) takes the sixth place globally in the International Trade Rankings 2023.

The two-year MBA journey at UCLA includes core courses that develop a solid foundation for business fundamentals and more than 115 specialized electives for students to choose from, based on their academic and professional interests. Candidates also enjoy employment-focused support such as career advice, networking activities, and industry guest speaker meetings by being a member of the Anderson Career Teams, support groups led by senior students and advisors from similar industry and business functions.

The Anderson School of Management connects MBA students with clients of all sizes, from Fortune 500 companies and startups to non-profits and microfinance institutions, for the management capstone projects as well as panel discussion and experiential learning workshops.

Trade Program Content

Designed to develop high-impact global leaders, the Anderson MBA provides unique opportunities for students to gain exposure to international business scenarios and develop a global mindset for trade leadership. Among the options is the Global Immersion Course that takes students to one of the school's target areas in Latin America and Asia Pacific to meet with people of strong influence to the host country's economy, policy and society. The wide range of offered courses and the prime focus on the transnational nature of business earn the program the fourth rank in Trade Program Content.



Graduate Outcome

The Parker Career Management Center provides support for the Anderson community and helps the program land its fifth place in Graduate Outcomes. The center personnel are well-connected with every sector of the global value chains and provide a wealth of career resources to MBA candidates, including expert-led professional development workshops dedicated to building leadership capacity and an internal job portal with exclusive postings from global-leading multinational enterprises.



Industry Engagement

Tasked to develop strategic recommendations, MBA students will be paired with businesses to perform market research, financial modelling and advantage analysis to accelerate and sustain the client's growth over the course of their study. The Anderson School also coordinates with industry organizations and governmental agencies to facilitate seminars, symposiums and policy briefs aimed at addressing critical issues that impact business, policy, society and management practices.
